King's Ely Year 12 Music Scholarship

For entry into Year 12, King's Ely offers Music Scholarships of up to 10 per cent of the day tuition fee are available. In addition, successful candidates *may* receive up to two free instrumental and/or vocal lessons.

Applications from external candidates should be accompanied by a registration form. All external candidates are required to sit the school entrance assessments, which take place in the November before September entry.

Some applicants may be offered free tuition only on up to two instruments, one of which must be an orchestral instrument. All successful candidates are expected to contribute fully to the musical life of King's Ely. All external candidates are required to meet the King's Ely Sixth Form entrance criteria.

The competition for Music Scholarships is intended to discover musical aptitude and promise. As a rough guide, Year 12 entry candidates should be at Grade 7 Distinction on their first instrument or voice, or performing to this level, if the actual grade is yet to be taken.
